Active vs. Passive Voice What is active voice? Active voice is a style of writing that puts the subject at the beginning of the sentence, followed by an action, and then the object that receives the action. Subject + Action + Object = Active Voice

Using Active Versus Passive Voice In a sentence using active voice, the subject of the sentence performs the action expressed in the verb. There are two voices in writing: Active and passive. In the active voice, the subject of a sentence acts, like "Neil Armstrong walked on the moon." The active voice is direct, clear, and easy to read. With the passive voice, the subject is acted upon, like "The moon was walked on by Neil Armstrong".

Active voice is used for most non-scientific writing. Using active voice for the majority of your sentences makes your meaning clear for readers, and keeps the sentences from becoming too complicated or wordy. Even in scientific writing, too much use of passive voice can cloud the meaning of your sentences.

One indicator that a sentence is written in the passive voice is that it comes with a "be" verb followed by a past participle. However, it is still possible for a sentence to be in the active voice despite having a form of the "be" verb in it. For instance, "I am eating a pie" is in the active voice despite the "be" verb ("am").

The active writing voice is contrasted with the passive voice. The active and passive voices put emphasis on different elements of the sentence. The active voice occurs when the subject "does" the action of the sentence. The passive voice occurs when the action is done by what seems like it should be the object.

Using the passive voice distances the subject from the action of the sentence, which leads to less clarity and urgency. It can also add unnecessary words to your manuscript, since the passive voice generally requires more auxiliary verbs than the active voice does.
